

3D2N Tabin Wildlife Observation & Nature Package

Description

The Tabin Wildlife Observation & Nature package is a 2 night stay at an exclusive rainforest resort located within Tabin Wildlife Reserve. Tabin Wildlife Reserve is the largest wildlife reserve in Malaysia, with a total land area of 123,000 hectare, and winner of the "Most promising tourist attraction" award.

From birdlife to nature, Tabin Wildlife Resort complements a visitors stay at the wildlife reserve by providing facilities including charming timber lodges built and blended within the natural surroundings, and a comprehensive range of nature-based activities.

Itinerary

DAY 1

You will be picked up in the east coast town of Lahad Datu and transferred by road to Tabin Wildlife Reserve (1:30 hrs journey). Check into an attractive timber lodge at Tabin Wildlife Resort, which comes complete with private balcony, ceiling fan and hot water shower - a welcome luxury in the forest. Nestled within the rainforest beside the Lipad river, this lovely setting is home to a surprising variety of birds, insects and small mammals, even right beside the buildings of the resort. Discover the rich variety of jungle herbs, some endemic, used for generations by local folks for the treatment of various ailments.

In the afternoon, visit the Lipad mud volcano which provides a mineral salt lick for wildlife. After trekking through the rainforest for 20 minutes, arrive at the elevated bare area of the mud volcano which is frequented by wildlife and birds. Try to identify the multitude of animal footprints here. Climb the observation tower and admire the contrasting landscape of the bare mud volcano and its surrounding thick forest, where birds are commonly sighted.

After dinner, enjoy a slide presentation on Tabin's natural wonders, followed by a trip to look out for nocturnal wildlife and birds. Remember to look up at the clear, dark sky of Tabin, identify the constellations above you and make a wish or two. (L,D)

DAY 2

You may opt to join the early morning bird walk to discover some of Tabin's rich collection of almost 300 bird species. After breakfast, trek through the lush green rainforest known for its rich diversity of plants and animal species to visit Lipad Waterfall. Take a dip in the natural pool and enjoy a natural and refreshing shower under the waterfall. Alternatively explore the surrounding vegetation or just relax.

In the afternoon you may wish to try out the Tabin Rainforest Foot Soak made with a natural blend of herbs, to relax tired muscles after long jungle treks. (B,L,D)

DAY 3

After breakfast, stroll to the nearby rock pool or river side where groups of macaques and other small mammals can sometimes be seen. Choose to take a dip in the river or simply listen to the sound of nature before saying good bye to Tabin. After lunch, depart for Lahad Datu airport for your transfer from the Resort. (B, L)

What to bring

Binoculars, leech socks, insect repellent, long sleeve shirts & long pants, raincoat, sun hat, swim wear, comfortable trekking shoes, torch light, water bottle & personal toiletries.

Included

Scheduled return transfer Lahad Datu / Tabin / Lahad Datu. Accommodation, meals as stated, guided tours and activities.

Excluded

Those not mentioned above including:- unscheduled transfers.

Trip Pre-Requisites

The area you will be staying in is located in a low-risk Malaria area. However, we advise our clients to visit their physician/doctor for the latest recommendation on protection against Malaria.

Trip Notes

The recommended flights to meet the scheduled transfers are as follows:

- BKI-LDU MH 3010 0700 /0755
- LDU-BKI MH 3023 1725/1820

Activities are subject to weather conditions, and may be re-organised to best meet operational situations.

Electric current is on a 240 Volts AC 50Hz cycle system using a square 3 pin plug.

Weather: Sabah is generally warm and fairly humid throughout the year, with temperatures ranging between 21 to 32 degrees centigrade in the lowlands. This can drop to as low as 21 degree centigrade in the highlands. Scattered unpredictable rains are common in Sabah and therefore difference in temperature is not extreme.

Medical: Hospitals, clinics and dispensaries are available in all major towns. It is advisable to take anti-malaria medication recommended by your doctor if you are visiting remote areas. Medical insurance is recommended.

Leeches are plenty on all trails. It is recommended you use leech socks during trekking activities.
