

## Day Trip - Tip Of Borneo

### Description

Stand on the northern most tip of Borneo, where the South China Sea meets the Sulu Sea.

Here, races from these seas have come ashore many hundred of years ago to settle the on coastal plains. The inhabitants have retained much of their traditional way of life. Mingle with the Bajaus and Dusuns at the local market before visiting the home of a Land bajau family to learn about the art of making "parang" (a Malaysan sheath-knife).

Continue your journey north for a simple meal with the Rungus people, well known for their traditional communal Longhouse dwelling, beadwork and weaving skills. After lunch, drive through coconut plantations to Simpang Magayau, the northern most tip of Borneo as you span the seas on this rocky cape.

### Itinerary

Please note actual time may differ. Pick up transfer time will be advised according to location of pick up.

7.00am - Pick up from your hotel in the morning. Drive to Kota Belud - see the Bajaus & Dusun people of Kota Belud at the market. Proceed to the Parang (Machete) making village.

10.00am - Drive to Kudat, where the Gong making village is located.

12.00pm - Proceed to the Rungus Longhouse for lunch in a Rungus Longhouse.

After lunch, you will be taken to the scenic Sempang Mengayau - the northern most part of Sabah - also known as the 'Tip Of Borneo'.

Expected return time to Kota Kinabalu is between 6.00 - 7.00pm.
